

Analogies: Sound Relationships

The words in these analogies are related by sound rather than by meaning. You will be matching three kinds of sound relationships:

SAME BEGINNING SOUND

cake : kind :: site : citizen

RHYMING WORDS

peas : freeze :: view : clue

HOMOPHONES

won : one :: too : two

Here's an example for you to try. crochet : ____ :: rein : stain

EXPLANTION: *Rein* and *stain* are rhyming words. Crochet is pronounced kro•SHAY. Among the word choices, the only word that rhymes is delay.
