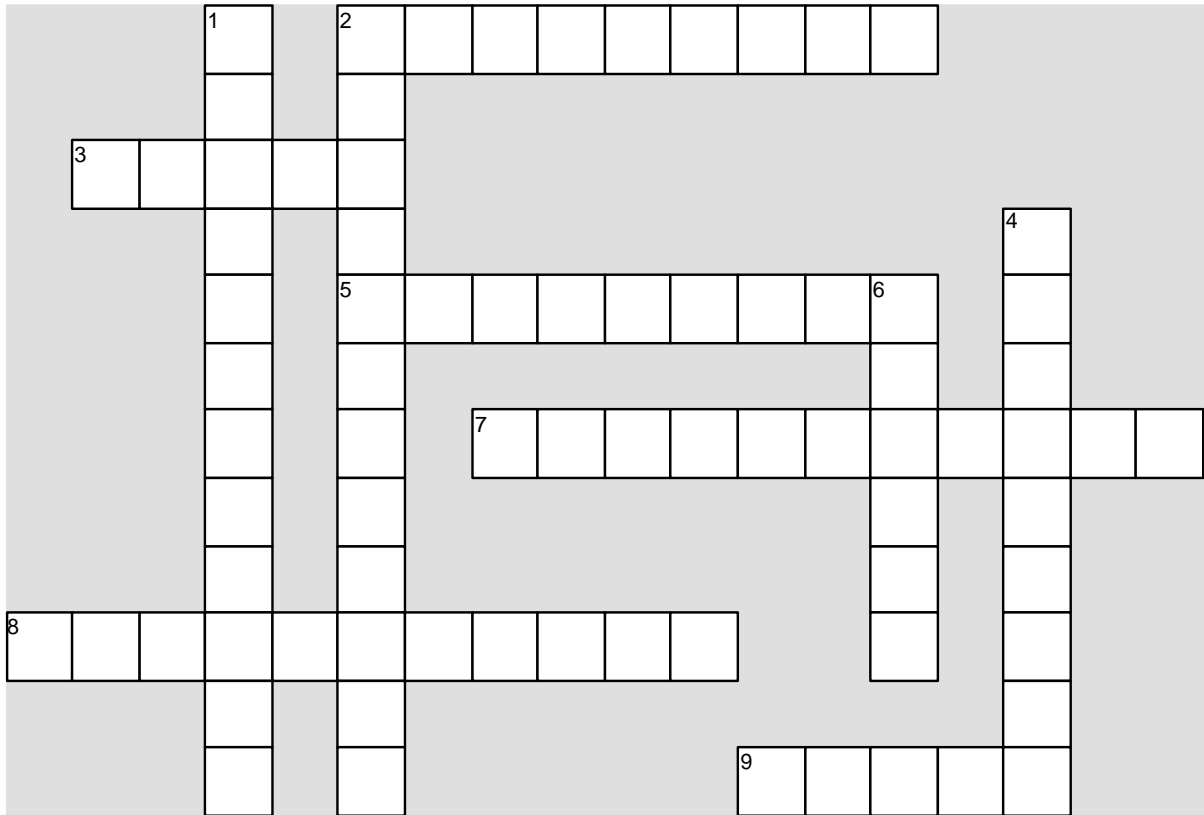
He offered Gina the job as manager of the new store. She was euphoric, but her happiness would never fully _____ her memories of those difficult first months in New York.
