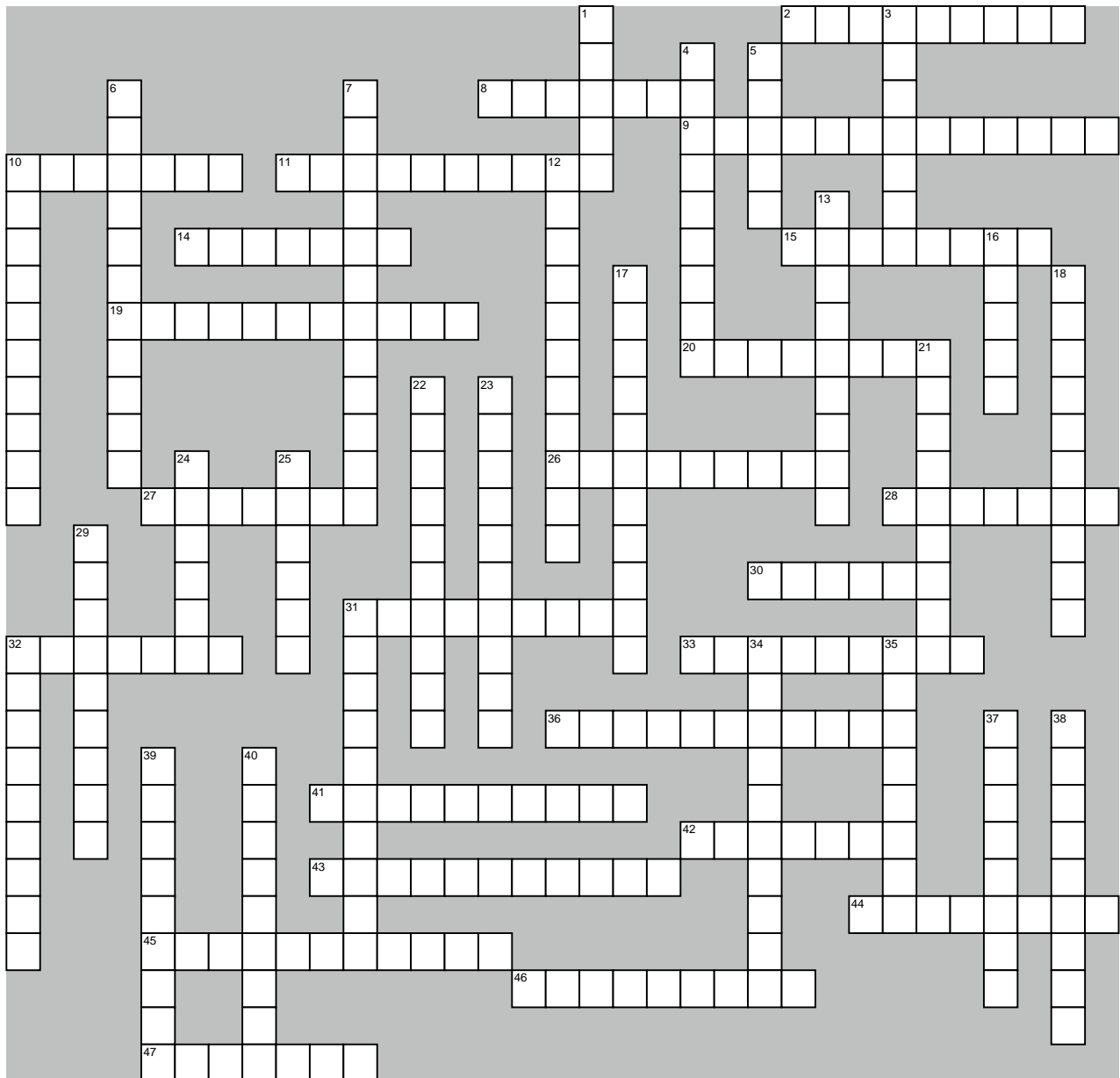


Unit 1 Review Crossword Puzzle
