## Finding Net Pay

Peter worked part-time bagging groceries. He wanted to find out what his net pay or take-home pay would be for a week.

To find his net pay Peter subtracted his total deductions from his gross pay. Peter's gross pay for one week was \$79.50. Deductions of \$25.19 were taken out of his check. He figured his net pay like this:

$$\$79.50 - \$25.19 = \$54.31$$

For that week Peter would actually receive \$54.31 take-home or net pay.
