Washington D.C. will be the site of a four day / three night educational tour for 40 Beatrice Middle School 8th graders, teachers, and parents. Worldstrides Educational Tours and 8th grade History and Civics teacher Michael Policky are sponsoring the trip. Final arrangements are being made for the trip that will run from May 27-30, 2009. Students will see Mount Vernon, George Washington's home; the White House, the Holocaust Museum, Arlington National Cemetery, and other sites in the Washington D.C. area. Policky noted the reason for sponsoring this trip was to provide students with a once in a lifetime opportunity to experience the history, culture, and government of our country's great capital.

Beatrice Middle School 7th graders and parents recently kicked off the 2010 Washington D.C. and Jamestown/Williamsburg trip scheduled for June 1-5, 2010. Early registration discounts are available up to June 1, 2009 for the 5day/4 night trip. Besides the discounted fares, it allows students and parents 11 months to work and pay off the trip. This trip is open to 8th graders (2009-2010 school year), parents, and older siblings who did not have the opportunity to go to Washington D.C. but who would still like the chance to gain the experience and education associated with such a trip.
