Who can attend: Students in grades K-5 for the 2017-2018 school year

What is B.L.A.S.T.: An after school learning and enrichment program

When: After school until 6:00 P.M.

Where: At the elementary school your student attends (Lincoln Elementary, Paddock Lane Elementary, or Stoddard Elementary)

Goal and Purpose: The goal is to provide extended learning opportunities and enrichment activities for all students in a safe, fun, learning environment, where parents will know their children are being well cared for in this critical time of the day. The program will offer a variety of hands-on activities geared toward providing fun engaging activities that are linked with the school's curriculum, aligning with state standards and career readiness.

Cost: \$8.00 per day. Students on Free or Reduced lunch will be no charge. A sliding fee scale is available.

Transportation: Transportation will not be provided. Parents will be responsible for picking up their students. The students will be able to stay until 6:00 p.m., however; parents may pick up their student at any time prior to 6:00 p.m. Additional fees may be assessed for student(s) not picked up by 6:00 p.m. A parent or another adult authorized by the parent(s) must sign your child out. It is important that one of the staff acknowledges this departure for the sake of the child's safety.

Snacks: Snacks will be provided for students attending the after school program. The snacks will be run through the school nutrition services and will follow the same guidelines as the school lunch program. All snack fees will be included in the school lunch program along with the breakfast and lunch costs.
