




ACADEMIC SHAPE FOR 2012-2013 — READING




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
ACADEMIC SHAPE FOR 2012-2013 — MATH










ACADEMIC SHAPE FOR 2012-2013 — SCIENCE









ACADEMIC SHAPE FOR 2012-2013 — WRITING





